### 1. Plan of Action.

Chair ask the council when we propose to carry out the events for the year.

Including the School Quiz, Titchmarsh's got talent and Fund Raising Cakes/ sweet stalls.

It was decided that Titchmarsh's got Talent should take place at the end of the school year in the last 2weeks. This will allow all the children to have time to practice and for it not to interfere with the normal school routine.

The school quiz is to be created and sent out to pupils after half term the school council have decided to write the questions for the quiz. Each year will have different questions. So that the school council members may be able to take part in the quiz we have decided that the Year 4 representatives would write the quiz for the Year3 quiz the Year 3's will write the Year 2 quiz and the year 2's the year1 quiz and the year 1's the owlets quiz the owlets will assist Miss Young in creating the year 4 quiz.

It has been decided that the quiz will be 50p to enter and there will be prizes for the winners. If more than 1 person from each year group got all the questions right their names will be put in a hat and we will ask Mrs Milton to pick a name out. The council decided that the winners will receive Easter themes prizes.

By the next meeting each of the representatives should have thought of at least 4 questions each for the school quiz.

### 2. Charities and Raising Money.
