

Book Bags

To make finding it easier you can attach one small keyring to the handle. Please bring your book bag to school every day.

Birthdays

If your birthday is on a school day you can come to school dressed in your own favourite clothes. You can also bring in small bags of sweets, such as Haribo to give to the children in the class if you would like to.

Snack

We have a fresh fruit or vegetable snack each day. Milk is also provided until you are five. After this your grown-ups can choose to pay for the milk. Please bring your named water bottle to school every day.

Lunch

You can bring a packed lunch (nut free) or have a school dinner. Your grown-ups don't have to pay for the school dinner until you are in Year 3 (aged 7-8). Please ask your grown up to order your school dinner by midnight on Wednesday ready for the following week. Please contact the school office if you need help.

Spare Clothes

Please bring in a spare set of clothes in a named bag. Please include socks, trousers or leggings, a t-shirt, a jumper and underwear in case you have an accident. The bag can stay on your peg for when you might need it.
